

## 200 Club Rules

## Purpose

The purpose of the 200 club is to raise funds for Much Marcle Community Shop, Café and Post Office. The money will be paid into the Shop bank account.

## Rules

- 1. For a cost of £36 per annum (i.e. £3 per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 200.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
- 3. The prizes will total approximately 30% of the annual income. The exact amount will depend upon the numbers within the club.
- 4. The prizes for December will be double the prize amount for the other 11 months.
- 5. The 200 club is a private lottery and is open to all supporters of the Community Shop. Anyone aged 16 or over can buy a number.
- 6. Payments must be made by a payment by cheque, card machine or BACS. One month's notice is required for cancellation. You will receive your number once the payment has been received.
- 7. Member's numbers will only be entered into the months draw if their subscription is up to date.
- 8. The draw shall be made at Hellens Produce Market on the first Saturday of each month or a public event.
- 9. The draw will commence when 100 members have purchased a number.
- 10. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
- 11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the Mercury, on the Shop Facebook page, and on the shop's website, with consent.
- 12. The 200 club will be run by the Steering Group of the Much Marcle Community Shop. In case of any dispute the decision of the group is final.
- 13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 200 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month following the renewal date.
- 14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the Shop funds after six months.
- 15. All personal information will be held securely and following the guidance of GPDR.
